What Are Opiates?

Opioids are a class of drugs used to reduce pain. They are commonly abused because of their extremely addictive nature. Common street drugs like Heroin and Fentanyl fall under the drug class of opiates. However, it is just as common to find prescription drugs being abused. These drugs include Morphine, Oxycodone, and Hydrocodone.

Opiates are typically in pill form, but can also be found in syrup form, crushed for snorting, and liquid for injection.

What Are the Signs of Opiate Addiction?

Opioid overdose is possible and happens frequently around the globe. In 2020, over 95,000 people died in a 365-day period. That is 260 individuals every day or about 11 people every hour.

It is important to be aware of the signs of opiate addiction. A person who is intoxicated with opiates may have an altered mental state. This means they may present as confused, delirious, or have decreased awareness or responsiveness. Individuals who are high can experience breathing problems, extreme sleepiness, nausea or vomiting, and have small pupils.

Opiate addiction also has a distinct sign that an individual may be using them called “the nod.” When addicts go “on the nod” they drift between consciousness, nodding in and out.

When a person presents at an opiate rehab center in Ohio, their symptoms are evaluated and they are placed into detox. During detoxification, an individual goes through withdrawal and the opiates burn out of their system. This can be a very uncomfortable process. Thankfully, at an opiate rehab center in Ohio, individuals are medically monitored and can be administered medication to decrease the negative side effects of withdrawal.

Following detoxification, individuals can choose between outpatient and inpatient care. Through this process, individuals go through group, independent, and/or family therapy to alter their cognitive beliefs and focus on the skills necessary for living a sober lifestyle.
